This inspection is at the request of C. Ybarra, District Manager, in response to a permit suspension for evidence of rodent activity. At this time, evidence of rodent activity was eliminated. Noted a pest control receipt dated 4/11/19 for service for rodents. The District Manager said that all the affected surfaces had been sanitized and traps were put in place. Continue with approved pest control and regularly check all areas of the facility.

The conditions causing the permit suspension were observed to be corrected. The facility permit to operate is hereby reinstated. A one-week reinspection is scheduled to verify that activity was effectively eliminated. A Reinspection Due Pass seal was posted.
