**OPENING COMMENTS**

This is a follow-up inspection at the request of the Director of Operations, C. Pun, in regards to the Health Permit suspension documented on 7/1/19. No evidence of vermin activity was observed with the exception old rodent droppings noted on item 24. This facility's Health Permit is hereby reinstated.

**24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - MAJOR**

Inspector Comments: Observed numerous old rodent droppings within the heating element area of the unattached chip warmer across from the handwashing sink. The Director of Operations proceeded by instructing employees to remove the unit from within the facility. A thorough inspection for vermin activity was conducted. No further evidence was observed.

NOTE: The Director of Operations agreed to notify this Agency prior to relocating the chip warmer into the facility.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)
