OPENING COMMENTS

This reinspection is at the request of the management at Wheel of Life Vegetarian Cuisine in response to the closure due to cockroach activity. On this date a thorough inspection was conducted throughout the facility. One dead cockroach was found on the floor in front of the ice machine, which an employee removed and discarded from the facility. No further evidence was observed. Pest control receipts were provided on this date. The health permit has been reinstated and the facility opened on 10/30/2019. A 3 week reinspection has been scheduled to verify that cockroach activity has been effectively eliminated from the facility.
