The purpose of this visit is at the request of J. Trejos, owner, to conduct a reinspection of a facility that was closed on 8/5/20 due to cockroach activity in critical areas. See inspection report for details.

At the time of reinspection, a pest control service receipt was provided showing service to the facility.

A thorough inspection for vermin was conducted and no further cockroach activity was observed. Additionally, the areas of concern as noted on the 8/5/20 inspection report were addressed.

The conditions causing the permit suspension were observed corrected and the health permit is hereby reinstated. You may reopen your restaurant to the public.

A 3 week reinspection has been scheduled to verify that the facility is free of vermin and a Reinspection Due Pass Seal was posted on this date.
