OPENING COMMENTS

A joint re-inspection with C. Gomez, REHS was conducted at the request of Carmen Castillo (executive assistant), in response to a permit suspension on November 19, 2019 for ongoing foodborne illness. The conditions causing the health permit suspension were observed to be corrected. Your health permit is hereby reinstated.

- 1) Hot water measured above 120 F.
- 2) "Attachment D" cleaning / sanitizing as outlined was completed on November 20, 2019 and a receipt was available for review.
- 3) All ready to eat unpackaged foods and single use open utensils and food packaging was voluntarily condemned and destroyed.
- 4) An Employee List with contacts was provided to this Agency.
- 5) A screening of employees will be implemented at the start of each shift using the provided "Employee Information" form and reported to Environmental Health at (714) 433-6418 daily through November 25, 2019. Employees may not return to work if they have had acute gastrointestinal symptoms such as vomiting and/or diarrhea within the past 72 hours.
- 6) Employee health and hygiene including proper handwashing and glove use reviewed and will be reiterated at the start of each shift.
- 7) Any further illness and or foodborne illness complaints will be reported to this Agency.
