OPENING COMMENTS

The purpose for this second visit is to follow up on correction of Critical Risk Factor FM24 that resulted in a closure of the facility on 06/27/2019. On this date, a thorough inspection was conducted and there was no evidence of cockroach activity observed. All affected areas were cleaned and sanitized. The owner showed evidence of sealing gaps throughout the facility and added new silicone caulking throughout the facility. Additionally, violations on the inspection report dated 06/27/2019 were also corrected (see routine inspection report dated 06/27/2019 for details). The owner presented pest control records and proof of active measures he is taking to prevent infestation. The Health Permit is hereby reinstated. You may now re-open for business. The Pass Notification Seal was posted today in a prominent location.
