OPENING COMMENTS

The purpose of this visit is at the request of Mr. Yu, owner, to conduct a reinspection of a facility that was closed on 9/11/18 due to a cockroach activity in critical areas.

At the time of reinspection, a pest control service receipt was provided showing recent service to the facility. A thorough inspection for vermin was conducted of the facility and no further evidence of cockroaches was observed. Continue to maintain the facility free of all vermin and maintain the facility in a clean and sanitary manner.

Continue to seal the cracks and crevices at the locations listed below:

A Reinspection Du Pass Seal was posted on this date on the date above to verify that the facility remains free of all vermin.

44. PREMISES: PERSONAL/CLEANING ITEMS; VERMIN-PROOFING - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Observed cracks and crevices in the facility at the locations listed below:

- 1) On the cross bar supports on the undersides of the prep tables in the facility.
- 2) Around the water supply lines for the prep sink where it enters the wall.
- 3) Along the cove base and wall next to and behind the cooling equipment at the main line.
- 4) At any other locations as reviewed during the course of reinspection.

Seal the cracks and crevices so as to prevent the entry and harborage of vermin in the facility.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof; open-air barbecues shall be operated in an approved manner.
