The purpose of this visit is to respond to a complaint (CO#) received by this Agency. The complaint alleges that there was no hot water in the facility.

The complaint was discussed with Gisele P. , an employee of the facility.

They stated that they had no hot water because the water heater stopped working.

It was observed on this date that there was no hot water over 100F and no low-temp dish detergent. Due to this reason, the facility was closed on this date.

22. HOT AND COLD WATER AVAILABLE - MAJOR

Inspector Comments: Observed the hot water at all sinks throughout the facility to measure 69F. An employee stated that the water heater was not functioning correctly. The unit was not able to be adjusted during this visit.

*The facility does not have low temp dish detergent either.

Provide hot water at 120F throughout the facility.

Violation Description: An adequate, protected, pressurized, potable supply of hot water and cold water shall be provided at all times. (113941, 113953c, 114099.2b, 114163, 114189, 114192, 114192.1, 114195)



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50. PERMIT SUSPENSION - IMMINENT HEALTH HAZARD

Inspector Comments: IMMEDIATE HEALTH PERMIT SUSPENSION AND CLOSURE

The permit to operate the above named food facility is hereby temporarily suspended, and the facility is ordered immediately closed under the authority of Sections 114405 and 114409 of Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3 of the California Health and Safety Code. The attached Inspection Report specifies the conditions that warrant this closure and the Sections of the law that are being violated.

Any food facility for which the permit has been temporarily suspended shall cease all food handling, close and remain closed until all conditions warranting the closure are corrected and your permit has been reinstated by a representative of Environmental Health.

You are hereby notified that you have the right to request a hearing, within 15 calendar days after service of this Notice to show cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Your failure to request a hearing within 15 calendar days shall be deemed a waiver of your right to a hearing.

An owner, manager or operator who fails to comply with this Closure Notice may be found guilty of a misdemeanor, with a possible fine of \$1,000.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than six months for each offense.

This Health Permit Suspension and Closure Notice is issued to you under the authority of the California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3. Copies of the Code Sections referred to herein may be reviewed at most public libraries, the Internet, or at Environmental Health.

Contact this office at the number noted on this report, during normal days of business to request a re-inspection, or if you have any questions.

If you are calling after 5:00 pm or on weekends, leave a message at (714) 433-6418 and an inspector/on call staff will call you back at their earliest convenience. REASON FOR CLOSURE: Insufficient Hot Water

Violation Description: If an imminent health hazard is found, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility immediately closed. (114409)
