OPENING COMMENTS

The purpose of this visit is at the request of the M. Ho, owner, to conduct a reinspection of a facility that was closed on 10/17/19 due to cockroach infestation at critical areas. See inspection report for details.

At the time of reinspection, a pest control service receipt was provided showing service to the facility the day prior. A thorough inspection for vermin was conducted throughout the bar and kitchen and no further evidence of cockroach activity was observed.

The bar dish machine that was found to not dispense sanitizer during the final rinse cycle the day prior was observed to be properly working and dispensing 50 ppm chlorine as required.

The conditions causing the permit suspension were observed corrected and your health permit is hereby reinstated. Continue to maintain the facility free of all vermin. A 3 week reinspection has been scheduled to verify that the facility remains free of all vermin.
