OPENING COMMENTS

The purpose of this visit is to follow up on the violations noted on the Notice of Violation dated 8-16-18. Refer to violations noted below.

24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - MAJOR

Inspector Comments: 1. Rodent droppings were observed in the following locations:

- in between the display drink cooler and the styrofoam cup storage shelf inside the dry food storage room
- in between the wall and the styrofoam cup storage shelf inside the dry food storage room
- on the floor behind the 2-door reach-in cooler located at the cook's line

2. One live cockroach was observed on the floor under the styrofoam cup storage shelf.

3. Dead cockroaches were observed in the following floor locations:

- under dry food storage shelves
- under the mop sink
- under the large pot storage shelf located outside of the walk-in cooler

4. Flies were observed in the facility.

Eliminate the infestation/activity of cockroaches/rodents/flies/vermin from the food facility by using only approved methods. Remove all evidence of the infestation and thoroughly clean and sanitize all affected surfaces. Construct, equip, maintain and operate the food facility so as to prevent the entrance and harborage of animals, birds and vermin including, but not limited to, rodents and insects.

The health permit has been temporarily suspended until all evidence of rodent and cockroach activity has been eliminated. Ensure to wash, rinse, and sanitize all food contact surfaces, non-food contact surfaces, all utensils, all equipment, floor, walls, and ceilings of the facility.

Once you are ready for a reinspection contact this Agency. An informational bulletin on the procedures to follow after a closure due to cockroach/rodent infestation was provided on this date.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)

52. PERMIT SUSPENSION - MAJOR

Inspector Comments: PERMIT SUSPENSION -- NONCOMPLIANCE WITH NOTICE OF VIOLATION

On <DATE> a Notice of Violation was issued by Environmental Health to the permittee of this food facility under the authority of Section 114405 of Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3 of the California Health and Safety Code. A reinspection was conducted this date and the attached Inspection Report describes the violations observed which have not been corrected. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Notice of Violation may result in suspension or revocation of your health permit. As stated in the Notice of Violation, failure to either request a hearing or attend a mandatory hearing, is deemed a waiver of your right to a hearing.

Your permit to operate this food facility is hereby suspended and the facility ordered to immediately close for failure to comply with the Notice of Violation. Any food facility for which the permit has been temporarily suspended shall cease all food handling, close and remain closed until all conditions warranting the closure are corrected and your permit has been reinstated by a representative of Environmental Health. Any food facility for which the permit has been suspended shall close and remain closed until all conditions warranting the closure are corrected and your permit reinstated by a representative of Environmental Health. An owner, manager or operator who fails to comply with this Closure Notice may be found guilty of a misdemeanor, with a possible fine of \$1,000.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than six months for each offense. Contact this office at the number noted above, during normal days of business to request a reinspection, or if you have any questions regarding this action.

The Closed Notification Seal was issued this date.

If you are calling after 5:00 pm or on weekends, leave a message at (714) 433-6418 and an inspector/on call staff will call you back at their earliest convenience. Please make after hour request calls before 8:00 pm. The afterhours overtime rate through June 30, 2019 is \$45.75 per quarter hour, or fraction thereof; time charged includes all travel time.

Violation Description: An enforcement officer may suspend or revoke the permit for non-compliance or for interference in the performance of the duty of the enforcement officer. (114405, 114409, 114411)

Note: On this date no food or equipment was observed stored inside the unpermitted storage room located next to the kitchen. Only observed janitorial supplies stored inside. However refer to city of Santa Ana building department for the addition of this storage room.
