OPENING COMMENTS

PERMIT REINSTATEMENT

This inspection is at the request of T. Gallegos, person in charge, in response to a permit suspension on 11-12-19 for rodent and cockroach activity and/or infestation. Upon arrival the following violations were observed, however all violations noted on the 11-12-19 report were corrected by the end of this inspection. A one week re-inspection has been scheduled for 11-20-19 to verify compliance.

The conditions causing the permit suspension were observed to be corrected. Your permit to operate is hereby reinstated.

24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Rodent droppings were observed around the table games located under the clean glass storage shelf at the bar. Eliminate the infestation/activity of cockroaches/rodents/flies/vermin from the food facility by using only approved methods. Remove all evidence of the infestation and thoroughly clean and sanitize all affected surfaces. Construct, equip, maintain and operate the food facility so as to prevent the entrance and harborage of animals, birds and vermin including, but not limited to, rodents and insects. A thorough inspection for vermin activity was conducted. No further evidence was observed.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)

34. NONFOOD-CONTACT SURFACES CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: An accumulation of grease and/or grime was observed in the following locations:

- on the underside of the deep fryer
- on the shelf under the food preparation table

Remove the grease and/or grime. Maintain all equipment in a clean and sanitary manner.

Violation Description: All nonfood-contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean. (114115 [c])

36. EQUIPMENT/UTENSILS - APPROVED; INSTALLED; GOOD REPAIR; CAPACITY - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: The display cooler located at the front counter measured at between 44F-45F. Repair/Adjust the refrigeration unit (s) so that the potentially hazardous foods are maintained at or below 41F.

Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114130.6, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114175, 114177, 114180, 114182)

45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: An accumulation of food debris and/or grime was observed on the wall behind the 3-compartment sink. Maintain the walls, floors, and ceiling in a clean and sanitary manner.

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, light-colored, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable, and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143(d), 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272)
