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OPENING COMMENTS

The purpose of this visit was to conduct a routine inspection.

As of June 18, 2018, partially hydrogenated oils (PHOs) are no longer recognized as safe for human consumption by Order of the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Any food product containing PHOs or trans fats used as a food ingredient must be discontinued and removed from the food facility. Refer to ocfoodinfo.com for further information.

6. HANDS CLEAN AND PROPERLY WASHED; GLOVES USED PROPERLY - MINOR

Inspector Comments: An employee was washing her hands at the 3-compartment sink. Hand washing must be done at the handsink. The employee was instructed to wash her hands at the handsink.

Violation Description: Employees are required to wash their hands with soap and warm water for a minimum of 10 seconds: before beginning work; before handling food / equipment / utensils; as often as necessary, during food preparation, to remove soil and contamination; when switching from working with raw to ready-to-eat foods, after touching body parts; after using toilet room; or any time when contamination may occur. Food employees shall minimize contact with exposed, ready-to-eat food with their bare hands and shall use suitable utensils, gloves, or dispensing equipment. Food employees shall keep their fingernails clean. Gloves shall be worn if a food employee has artificial nails, nail polish, rings, or orthopedic support devices. (113952, 113953.3, 113953.4, 113961, 113968, 113973 [b-f])

7. ADEQUATE HANDWASHING FACILITIES SUPPLIED & ACCESSIBLE - MINOR

Inspector Comments: 1. At the kitchen handsink, paper towel was placed outside the dispenser.
2. In the restroom, the paper towel dispenser was empty.
Refill the empty paper towel dispenser.

Violation Description: Handwashing facilities must be provided. Handwashing soap and single-use towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. Handwashing facilities shall be clean, unobstructed, and accessible. (113953, 113953.1, 113953.2, 114067)

8. PROPER HOT AND COLD HOLDING TEMPERATURES - MINOR

Inspector Comments: The following foods were measured at the respective temperatures:
1. 2-door Traulsen cooler: Mexican cream 61F
The person in charge stated that the food had been held for over night.

The violation was corrected by an employee discarding the food. Refer to item 53.

- 2. 2-door Traulsen cooler: fresh salsa 53F (the employee stated that it was just made).
- 3. Upright cooler: shrimp 45F, raw beef 47F
- 4. Warmer: steak with onions 1250-131F

Violation Description: Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41°F or at or above 135°F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a), 114004)



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24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - MAJOR

Inspector Comments: Observed one live roach and one dead roach in the handsink.
Observed numerous dead roaches at the wall of the upright cooler, on the floors under the 3-compartment sink and under the fryer.
Eliminate the infestation/activity of cockroaches/rodents/flies/vermin from the food facility by using only approved methods. Remove all evidence of the infestation and thoroughly clean and sanitize all affected surfaces. Construct, equip, maintain and operate the food facility so as to prevent the entrance and harborage of animals, birds and vermin including, but not limited to, rodents and insects.

Active Pest Control serviced the facility monthly, last service: 8/23/18. Continue with your pest control service.

Information bulletin on Procedures Following a Health Permit Suspension Due to Cockroach Activity was provided this date.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)

28. FOOD SEPARATED AND PROTECTED - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: 1. Raw shrimp was placed on top of ready to eat foods in the upright cooler.
Store ready-to-eat foods above or separately from raw animal products. 2. Observed many uncovered food items in the upright coolers and reach-in cooler.

Provide sanitary, non-absorbent and approved coverings on all open food containers except when in use.

Violation Description: All food shall be separated and protected from contamination. (113980, 113984, 113986, 114060, 114067, 114077, 114073, 114143)

30. TOXIC SUBSTANCES PROPERLY IDENTIFIED, STORED, USED - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: 1. A chemical spray bottle was not labeled.
Working containers used for storing chemicals such as cleaners and sanitizers taken from bulk supplies shall be clearly and individually identified with the common name of the material.

Violation Description: All poisonous substances, detergents, bleaches, and cleaning compounds shall be stored separate from food, utensils, packaging materials, and food-contact surfaces, and shall be used in an approved manner. (114254, 114254.1, 114254.2)

34. NONFOOD-CONTACT SURFACES CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: CLEANING:
1. Remove grease from the side panels of the fryer and reach-in cooler.
2. Remove grease from the hood filters.
3. Remove grime / residue from the shelves and rust in the upright cooler. If rust is not cleanable, replace the shelves.
4. Remove grime / residue from the shelves in the glass door upright cooler.

Violation Description: All nonfood-contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean. (114115 [c])

35. WAREWASHING FACILITIES: INSTALLED, MAINTAINED, USED; TEST STRIPS

Inspector Comments: 1. 1 drain stop was missing from the 3-compartment sink.
Provide functional drain stops to achieve proper warewashing.

Violation Description: Food facilities that prepare food shall be equipped with warewashing facilities. Testing equipment and materials shall be provided to measure the applicable sanitization method. (114067(f,g), 114099, 114099.3, 114099.5, 114101(a), 114101.1, 114101.2, 114103, 114107, 114125)



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36. EQUIPMENT/UTENSILS - APPROVED; INSTALLED; GOOD REPAIR; CAPACITY - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Repair/Adjust the refrigeration unit (s) [glass door upright cooler and meat upright cooler] so that the potentially hazardous foods are maintained at or below 41F.

Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114130.6, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114175, 114177, 114180, 114182)

37. EQUIPMENT, UTENSILS AND LINENS: STORAGE AND USE - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: 1. An ice scoop was placed inside the ice machine.

Store the ice scoop in a sanitary, cleanable container or inside the ice machine/bin in a manner that does not allow the handle to come into contact with the ice. Clean the scoop regularly.

Violation Description: All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.3, 114185.4, 114185.5)

41. PLUMBING; PROPER BACKFLOW DEVICES - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: 1. There was no air gaps between the waste pipe and floor sink drain at the ice machine. Provide a 1 inch air gap between the waste pipe and floor sink drain.

Violation Description: The potable water supply shall be protected with a backflow protection device, as required by applicable plumbing codes. All plumbing, plumbing fixtures, and grease interceptors shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances, shall be maintained so as to prevent any contamination, and shall be kept clean, fully operative, and in good repair. Any hose used for conveying potable water shall be of approved materials, labeled, properly stored, and used for no other purpose. (14171, 114189.1, 114190, 114192, 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269)

42. GARBAGE AND REFUSE PROPERLY DISPOSED; FACILITIES MAINTAINED - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Observed the trash dumpster and/or grease receptacle to be uncovered.

Violation Description: All food waste and rubbish shall be kept in leak-proof and rodent-proof containers. Containers shall be covered at all times. All waste must be removed and disposed of as frequently as necessary to prevent a nuisance. The exterior premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish. (114244, 114245, 114245.1, 114245.2, 114245.3, 114245.4, 114245.5, 114245.6, 114245.7, 114245.8)

44. PREMISES: PERSONAL/CLEANING ITEMS; VERMIN-PROOFING - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Aprons were hung on the food rack.

Maintain employee clothing and personal effects in a room, enclosure, lockers, or other designated area or designated area separated from toilets, food storage, food preparation areas and utensil washing areas.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof; open-air barbecues shall be operated in an approved manner. (114067(j), 114123, 114143(a)&(b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282)



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45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: 1. Remove grease and debris from the floors of the entire facility especially under the fryer.

2. Observed flooring in disrepair (i.e. deteriorating or missing grout/tiles/vinyl, etc). Repair the floor in order to provide a surface that is smooth, durable, non-absorbent and easily cleanable. If flooring is to be replaced, submit a sample to this office prior to installation.

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, light-colored, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable, and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143(d), 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272)

47. SIGNS POSTED; LAST INSPECTION REPORT AVAILABLE - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: The last inspection report was unavailable for review at the public's request. Retain a copy of the most recent inspection report on the premises available for review at the request of the public.

Violation Description: Handwashing signs shall be posted in each toilet room, directing attention to the need to thoroughly wash hands after using the restroom. No smoking signs shall be posted in food preparation, food storage, warewashing, and utensil storage areas. Consumers shall be notified that clean tableware is to be used when they return to self-service areas such as salad bars and buffets. Any food facility constructed before January 1, 2004 without public toilet facilities, shall prominently post a sign within the food facility in a public area stating that toilet facilities are not provided. The most recent routine inspection report shall be maintained at the food facility and a sign shall be posted to advise patrons of its availability for review. The health permit must be posted in a conspicuous location. (113725.1, 113945.1, 113953.5, 113978, 114075, 114276, 114381 [e])



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50. PERMIT SUSPENSION - IMMINENT HEALTH HAZARD

Inspector Comments: IMMEDIATE HEALTH PERMIT SUSPENSION AND CLOSURE

The permit to operate the above named food facility is hereby temporarily suspended, and the facility is ordered immediately closed under the authority of Sections 114405 and 114409 of Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3 of the California Health and Safety Code. The attached Inspection Report specifies the conditions that warrant this closure and the Sections of the law that are being violated.

Any food facility for which the permit has been temporarily suspended shall cease all food handling, close and remain closed until all conditions warranting the closure are corrected and your permit has been reinstated by a representative of Environmental Health.

You are hereby notified that you have the right to request a hearing, within 15 calendar days after service of this Notice to show cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Your failure to request a hearing within 15 calendar days shall be deemed a waiver of your right to a hearing.

An owner, manager or operator who fails to comply with this Closure Notice may be found guilty of a misdemeanor, with a possible fine of \$1,000.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than six months for each offense.

This Health Permit Suspension and Closure Notice is issued to you under the authority of the California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3. Copies of the Code Sections referred to herein may be reviewed at most public libraries, the Internet, or at Environmental Health.

Contact this office at the number noted above, during normal days of business to request a re-inspection, or if you have any questions.

If you are calling after 5:00 pm or on weekends, leave a message at (714) 433-6418 and an inspector/on call staff will call you back at their earliest convenience. Please make after hour request calls before 8:00 pm. The afterhours overtime rate through June 30, 2019 is \$45.75 per quarter hour, or fraction thereof; time charged includes all travel time.

The CLOSED notification seal was issued this date.

REASON FOR CLOSURE: live and dead roaches in the kitchen.

Violation Description: If an imminent health hazard is found, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility immediately closed. (114409)

53. VOLUNTARY CONDEMNATION & DESTRUCTION (VC&D)

Inspector Comments: 1/8 lbs of Mexican cream was discarded in the trash for improper holding temperatures.

Violation Description: Food, equipment, or utensils that are found to be unsanitary or in disrepair may be Voluntarily Condemned and Destroyed by the person in charge. (111890, 111895)
