Items noted below were observed during the course of this inspection. Any violations observed must be corrected. Failure to correct the listed violation(s) prior to the designated compliance date may necessitate a reinspection at an additional fee.

OPENING COMMENTS

The purpose of this visit was to conduct a follow up inspection in regard to the conditions that led to the previous health permit suspension. No cockroach activity was observed this date. The health permit was suspended on this date due to rodent activity, see FM 50.

24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Observed rodent droppings in the following critical areas:

- 1) one on the floor behind the reach-in cooler at the main prep area
- 2) multiple on the floor behind the tortilla chip warmer located at the end of the cook's line
- 3) one on the white lid boxes located at the hostess stand located in front of the beverage dispensing area
- 4) multiple on the floor located at the foot of the hostess stand located in front of the beverage dispensing area

Eliminate the activity of rodents from the food facility by using only approved methods. Remove all evidence of the infestation and thoroughly clean and sanitize all affected surfaces. Construct, equip, maintain and operate the food facility so as to prevent the entrance and harborage of animals, birds and vermin including, but not limited to, rodents and insects.

Corrective Action Taken: The health permit was suspended on this date, refer to FM 50.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)

44. PREMISES: PERSONAL/CLEANING ITEMS; VERMIN-PROOFING - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: 1) Rodent-proof the building/facility.

- 2) Install a rodent-proof barn door to prevent rodent entry into the food facility. Ensure there are no gaps at the sides or bottom of the door that exceed 1/4 inch.
- 3) Remove the textured decorative wall covering on the front of the food facility.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof; open-air barbecues shall be operated in an approved manner. 45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Effectively clean and sanitize the floor surfaces of the affected areas:

- the cook's line
- the prep area
- the hostess stand/front beverage dispensing area

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, light-colored, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable, and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143(d), 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272)

50. PERMIT SUSPENSION - IMMINENT HEALTH HAZARD

Inspector Comments: IMMEDIATE HEALTH PERMIT SUSPENSION AND CLOSURE

The permit to operate the above named food facility is hereby temporarily suspended, and the facility is ordered immediately closed under the authority of Sections 114405 and 114409 of Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3 of the California Health and Safety Code. The attached Inspection Report specifies the conditions that warrant this closure and the Sections of the law that are being violated.

Any food facility for which the permit has been temporarily suspended shall cease all food handling, close and remain closed until all conditions warranting the closure are corrected and your permit has been reinstated by a representative of Environmental Health.

You are hereby notified that you have the right to request a hearing, within 15 calendar days after service of this Notice to show cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Your failure to request a hearing within 15 calendar days shall be deemed a waiver of your right to a hearing.

An owner, manager or operator who fails to comply with this Closure Notice may be found guilty of a misdemeanor, with a possible fine of \$1,000.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than six months for each offense.

This Health Permit Suspension and Closure Notice is issued to you under the authority of the California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3. Copies of the Code Sections referred to herein may be reviewed at most public libraries, the Internet, or at Environmental Health.

Contact this office at the number noted above, during normal days of business to request a re-inspection, or if you have any questions.

If you are calling after 5:00 pm or on weekends, leave a message at (714) 433-6418 and an inspector/on call staff will call you back at their earliest convenience. Please make after hour request calls before 8:00 pm. The afterhours overtime rate through June 30, 2019 is \$45.75 per quarter hour, or fraction thereof; time charged includes all travel time.

REASON FOR CLOSURE: RODENT ACTIVITY IN CRITICAL AREAS

ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD/BEVERAGE PREP OR SALES MAY OCCUR IN THIS FACILITY WITHOUT PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THIS AGENCY.

Prior to calling for a reinspection all of the violations listed on this report must be corrected, including, but not limited to, the following:

- 1) Eliminate all rodent activity from this facility using approved pest control methods (refer to #24).
- 2) Clean and sanitize all surfaces to eliminate rodent contamination, including, but not limited to, all prep tables, food equipment, food containers, shelves, and floors.
- 3) Rodent proof the facility/building. Properly eliminate/seal potential points of entry such as holes and gaps in the walls, basecoves, ceiling, and under all exterior doors to prevent vermin entrance, including, but not limited, to those listed in #44 & #45.

NOTE: The installation of the barn door and removal of the textured decorative wall covering noted in violation # 44 must be corrected prior to the reinspection that will be scheduled after this facility has been reopened.

Violation Description: If an imminent health hazard is found, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility immediately closed. (114409)
