OPENING COMMENTS

This visit is at the request of the management of Super Mex Mexican Restaurant due to a closure for cockroach activity. On this date a thorough inspection was conducted throughout the facility and no further evidence of activity was observed. Holes/crevices noted on the routine report were observed sealed. Receipts of approved pest control methods were provided on this date. Per owner food surfaces had been cleaned and sanitized. The health permit has been reinstated and the facility reopened on 10/30/2019. A 3 week reinspection has been scheduled to verify that cockroach activity has been effectively eliminated.
