OPENING COMMENTS

*This report supersedes all previous reports.

The purpose of this visit was to verify abatement of the rodent infestation resulting in a closure.

On this date, pest control receipts dated 10-17-19 were reviewed. No evidence of rodent droppings was observed on this date. All areas of cleanliness noted on the report including the air vents in the kitchen and the floor drains at the bar were cleaned. No cardboard was noted to line the shelving units. The pressurized cylinders in the kitchen were securely fastened. Covers and protection were provided to the food in the walk-in cooler. New faucets and pipes were provided for the leaky handwashing sink, soap and permanently installed paper towel dispensers were observed newly installed at handwash sinks, and new gaskets were provided for the TURBO-AIR cold-top refrigeration unit.

All major and minor violations noted on the report were observed corrected on this date.

Continue to correct the violations below:

24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: 1 live cockroach was observed in front of the bar area and was killed onsite. After a thorough inspection, no other evidence was observed.

The area of the floor was washed, rinsed, and sanitized.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)

28. FOOD SEPARATED AND PROTECTED - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Discontinue placing raw shell eggs above uncovered or ready-to-eat foods.

Violation Description: All food shall be separated and protected from contamination. (113980, 113984, 113986, 114060, 114067, 114077, 114073, 114143)
