OPENING COMMENTS

This visit is at the request of 101 Noodle Express management due to a facility closure for cockroaches. On this date a thorough inspection was conducted and no further evidence of cockroach activity was observed. Receipts for pest control services were provided and all holes/crevices noted in the routine report were observed sealed. A 3 week reinspection has been scheduled to verify that vermin activity has been effectively eliminated from the facility.

24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - MINOR

Inspector Comments: Several old rodent droppings were observed on the floor underneath the shelving in the side storage room. Corrective action: Employee cleaned the affected area and disposed of the droppings. No further evidence was observed.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)

45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments:
Thoroughly clean and maintain the floors throughout the side storage room.

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, light-colored, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable, and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143(d), 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272)
