OPENING COMMENTS

The purpose of this visit was to conduct a 2nd after hours reinspection at the request of the Kitchen Supervisor, Jonathan due to a health permit suspension on 12/26/18 for cockroach infestation. All violations noted on the inspection report were corrected by the end of the inspection. A thorough inspection was conducted and no further cockroach activity was noted. Pest control receipts provided.

Health permit reinstated. Please note that a reinspection is scheduled for 1/22/18.

24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - MINOR

Inspector Comments: A dead cockroach and a dying cockroach were noted on the floor under the prep table across from the cook's line. Both cockroaches were removed and the affected area was cleaned/sanitized.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)

45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Observed a large hole in the wall in the back area where multi use equipment is stored. Corrected on-site.

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, light-colored, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable, and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143(d), 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272)
