OPENING COMMENTS

This inspection was at the request of C. Mecias (Store Manager) in response to a permit suspension on 12/31/18 for cockroach and rodent activity.

F. Pinedo (Director of Store Operations) was present during the inspection.

At the time of the inspection, the following conditions were noted:

1. Rodent and cockroach activity was not observed in the bakery department.
 2. Entry points were observed to be sealed or temporarily sealed.
 3. The accumulation of food, dirt, trash, and/or debris at the noted locations were observed to be removed.
 4. Holes, cracks, gaps, and/or crevices at the noted locations were observed to be sealed.
 5. A pest control receipt dated 1/1/19 was provided at the time of the inspection.
- Continue to monitor all areas of the facility for activity and continue with approved pest control measures.

A 1-week reinspection is scheduled for 1/9/19 to verify continued abatement of vermin activity.

The conditions causing the permit suspension were observed to be corrected. Your permit to operate is hereby reinstated.

34. NONFOOD-CONTACT SURFACES CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments:

1. Observed an accumulation of residue, grime, and/or debris in the crevice between the two revert oven machines at the bakery department. An employee removed the accumulation during the inspection.

Violation Description: All nonfood-contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean. (114115 [c])
