Inspector Comments: 1) Rodent-proof the building/facility.  
2) Install a rodent-proof barn door to prevent rodent entry into the food facility. Ensure there are no gaps at the sides or bottom of the door that exceed 1/4 inch.  
3) Remove the textured decorative wall covering on the front of the food facility.  
Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof; open-air barbecues shall be operated in an approved manner.
