OPENING COMMENTS

This afterhours reinspection is at the request of the owner (Bernie) following the permit suspension due to a cockroach infestation on 10-4-19.

Per Bernie when requesting the reinspection this facility was reopened after the pest control technician left at approximately 5pm this date. Owner was advised that the permit was suspended and may not reopen without written permission from this office. Upon arrival this facility was not in operation. A thorough inspection was conducted and no evidence of a cockroach infestation was observed at the walls near the dishmachine/comp sink. While repairs were made to the walls by the dishmachine/2 comp sink the surfaces were still observed rough. Continue your efforts to provide a smooth, durable, and easily cleanable surface.

Pest control receipt provided this date.

Permit was reinstated and a Reinspection seal was posted.

45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Continue your efforts to provide a smooth, durable, and cleanable surface for the walls by the dishmachine/2 comp sink.

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, light-colored, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable, and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143(d), 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272)
