**OPENING COMMENTS**

The purpose of this visit is to respond to a complaint(CO0071821) received by this Agency. The complaint alleges that, sewage overflow from under the facility.

The complaint was discussed with Alex Flores, Person in charge.

Observed this complaint to be justified. Observed sewage water coming out from under the outside metal stairs of the food facility entrance.

This facility's health permit was suspended due to the sewage spill.

This facility is to remain closed until a representative from our Office can verify the plumbing has been repaired and the sewage spillage has stopped. Please contact our Agency when you are ready to schedule a reinspection.

**23. SEWAGE AND WASTEWATER PROPERLY DISPOSED - MAJOR**

Inspector Comments: Observed sewage water coming out from under the outside metal stairs of the food facility entrance. Observed the plumbing drain line to partially empty onto the floor under and in front of the outside metal stairs and partially drain in-directly into the sump pump sewage drain. Discontinue this practice. Immediately discontinue this sewage spill discharge. Ensure all sewage is properly drained into the sewer line.

Corrective action: The facility's health permit was suspended. The operator has discontinued using the plumbing ( 3-compartment sink ,1-compartment sink, and mopsink) and water at the facility. The person in charge has cleaned and sanitized all affected areas of the sewage spill.

Violation Description: All liquid waste must drain to an approved fully functioning sewage disposal system; toilets shall be operable. (114197)

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**50. PERMIT SUSPENSION - IMMINENT HEALTH HAZARD**

Inspector Comments: IMMEDIATE HEALTH PERMIT SUSPENSION AND CLOSURE

The permit to operate the above named food facility is hereby temporarily suspended, and the facility is ordered immediately closed under the authority of Sections 114405 and 114409 of Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3 of the California Health and Safety Code. The attached Inspection Report specifies the conditions that warrant this closure and the Sections of the law that are being violated.

Any food facility for which the permit has been temporarily suspended shall cease all food handling, close and remain closed until all conditions warranting the closure are corrected and your permit has been reinstated by a representative of Environmental Health.

You are hereby notified that you have the right to request a hearing, within 15 calendar days after service of this Notice to show cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Your failure to request a hearing within 15 calendar days shall be deemed a waiver of your right to a hearing.

An owner, manager or operator who fails to comply with this Closure Notice may be found guilty of a misdemeanor, with a possible fine of \$1,000.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than six months for each offense.

This Health Permit Suspension and Closure Notice is issued to you under the authority of the California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3. Copies of the Code Sections referred to herein may be reviewed at most public libraries, the Internet, or at Environmental Health.

Contact this office at the number noted on this report, during normal days of business to request a re-inspection, or if you have any questions.

To request a reinspection prior to 5:00 pm, please call (714) 433-6000. If you are calling after 5:00 pm or on weekends, leave a message at (714) 433-6418 and an inspector/on call staff will call you back at their earliest convenience. Please make after hour request calls before 8:00 pm. The afterhours overtime rate through June 30, 2020 is \$45.75 per quarter hour, or fraction thereof; time charged includes all travel time.

The CLOSED notification seal was issued this date.

REASON FOR CLOSURE: Sewage spill coming from the under the metal stairs located at the entrance of the food facility.

Violation Description: If an imminent health hazard is found, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility immediately closed. (114409)
