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**OPENING COMMENTS**

During this routine inspection this facility's health permit was suspended due to cockroach activity in critical areas. Refer to FM50.

**15. FOOD CONTACT SURFACES: CLEAN AND SANITIZED - MINOR**

Inspector Comments: Measured the sanitizer concentration in the wiping cloth container to be low/inadequate (<200ppm quaternary ammonium). Change the solution as needed when it becomes weak or cloudy with food residue.

Corrective Action: The person in charge discarded the low sanitizer solutions and provided sanitizer solution at adequate levels inside the sanitizer container.

Violation Description: All food contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean and sanitized. (113984(d), 114097, 114099.1, 114099.4, 114099.6, 114101(b-d), 114105, 114109, 114111, 114113, 114115(a, b, d), 114117, 114125(b), 114141)

**24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - MAJOR**

Inspector Comments: Observed the following:

- 1) One live juvenile german cockroach on the floor beneath the one-door Turbo Air freezer located in the kitchen.
- 2) One live juvenile german cockroach on the exterior surface of the pull-out drawer station located next to the one-door Turbo Air freezer located in the kitchen.

Remove all evidence of cockroach activity. Thoroughly clean and sanitize all affected surfaces to eliminate cockroach contamination.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)

**34. NONFOOD-CONTACT SURFACES CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE**

Inspector Comments: Thoroughly clean to remove the accumulation of food debris/grease residue from the following areas:

- 1) on the exhaust filters located on the back side of the hood above the deep frying equipment station.
- 2) on the ansel sprinklers located on the back side of the hood above the deep frying equipment station.
- 3) on the exterior surfaces of the flat grill in the kitchen
- 4) on the exterior surfaces of the 4-burner equipment located in between the hot holding station and flat grill station in the kitchen.

Violation Description: All nonfood-contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean. (114115 [c])

**36. EQUIPMENT/UTENSILS - APPROVED; INSTALLED; GOOD REPAIR; CAPACITY - OUT OF COMPLIANCE**

Inspector Comments: 1. Observed the cutting board located at the cook's station next to the hand wash sink in the kitchen to have surfaces that are uneven and heavily scored. Resurface or replace the cutting board to provide surfaces that are smooth, even and easily cleanable.

2. Repair the leaking compartments at the 3-compartment sink, (wash compartment and sanitizer compartment).

Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114130.6, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114175, 114177, 114180, 114182)



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**44. PREMISES: PERSONAL/CLEANING ITEMS; VERMIN-PROOFING - OUT OF COMPLIANCE**

Inspector Comments: A. Seal the following areas to prevent harborage of german cockroaches in the facility:

1. on the junction where the wall and floor meet located to the left low corner of the 1-door Turbo Air freezer in the kitchen.
2. on the floor beneath the pull-out drawer located next to the 1-door Turbo Air freezer in the kitchen.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof; open-air barbecues shall be operated in an approved manner. (114067(j), 114123, 114143(a)&(b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282)

**45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE**

Inspector Comments: A. Thoroughly clean to remove food debris/grease residue from the following areas:

- 1) on the floor beneath the 1-door Turbo Air freezer
- 2) on the floor beneath the deep fryer station
- 3) on the floor beneath the salad station
- 4) on the floor beneath the flat grill station
- 5) remove the excess ice from the floor in the walk-in freezer.

B. Replace deteriorating floor tiles in the kitchen located beneath the 1-door Turbo Air freezer.

C. Observed a flat cardboard box stored on the floor in the kitchen. Discontinue using cardboard boxes after the original food product has been removed from the cardboard box.

D. Seal the gaps and openings from the following areas:

- 1) on the ceiling above the water heater located in the dry storage room
- 2) on the wall beneath the 3-compartment sink
- 3) beneath the mop sink around the plumbing pipe
- 4) on the wall to the right side of the utensil storage racks closest to the employee break room.

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, light-colored, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable, and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143(d), 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272)



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**50. PERMIT SUSPENSION - IMMINENT HEALTH HAZARD**

Inspector Comments: IMMEDIATE HEALTH PERMIT SUSPENSION AND CLOSURE

The permit to operate the above named food facility is hereby temporarily suspended, and the facility is ordered immediately closed under the authority of Sections 114405 and 114409 of Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3 of the California Health and Safety Code. The attached Inspection Report specifies the conditions that warrant this closure and the Sections of the law that are being violated.

Any food facility for which the permit has been temporarily suspended shall cease all food handling, close and remain closed until all conditions warranting the closure are corrected and your permit has been reinstated by a representative of Environmental Health.

You are hereby notified that you have the right to request a hearing, within 15 calendar days after service of this Notice to show cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Your failure to request a hearing within 15 calendar days shall be deemed a waiver of your right to a hearing.

An owner, manager or operator who fails to comply with this Closure Notice may be found guilty of a misdemeanor, with a possible fine of \$1,000.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than six months for each offense.

This Health Permit Suspension and Closure Notice is issued to you under the authority of the California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3. Copies of the Code Sections referred to herein may be reviewed at most public libraries, the Internet, or at Environmental Health.

Contact this office at the number noted on this report, during normal days of business to request a re-inspection, or if you have any questions.

If you are calling after 5:00 pm or on weekends, leave a message at (714) 433-6418 and an inspector/on call staff will call you back at their earliest convenience. Please make after hour request calls before 8:00 pm. The afterhours overtime rate through June 30, 2019 is \$45.75 per quarter hour, or fraction thereof; time charged includes all travel time.

REASON FOR CLOSURE: Cockroach activity in critical areas.

ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD/BEVERAGE PREP OR SALES MAY OCCUR IN THIS FACILITY WITHOUT PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THIS AGENCY.

Prior to calling for a reinspection all of the violations listed on this report must be corrected, including, but not limited to, the following:

- 1) Eliminate all live and dead cockroaches using approved pest control methods (refer to #24).
- 2) Remove all excess clutter and cardboard from the facility, as well as personal belongings, to allow for effective pest control service and to prevent future harborage of cockroaches and other vermin.
- 3) Clean and sanitize all equipment surfaces, food containers, shelves, walls and floors to eliminate all cockroach and pesticide contamination particularly all areas where live or dead cockroaches or cockroach spotting were observed, including, but not limited to, those areas listed in #24.
- 4) Properly eliminate/seal all cracks and crevices to prevent vermin harborage, including, but not limited to, those listed in #44 & #45.
- 5) Have your pest control receipt available for review by the Environmental Health Specialist responding to your request for reinspection. Without proof that it is safe for the Specialist to enter your facility the reinspection will not occur. Enter your facility only after it is safe to do so.

NOTE: Violations numbers #34,#36, #44 and #45 must be corrected prior to the reinspection that will be scheduled after this facility has been reopened.

Violation Description: If an imminent health hazard is found, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility immediately closed. (114409)
