OPENING COMMENTS

This is a follow up inspection regarding the violations noted on 06.07.19.

This inspection is at the request of WAIS OMAR, Operator in response to a permit suspension on 06.07.19 for rodent activity. The conditions causing the permit suspension were observed to be corrected. Your permit to operate is hereby reinstated.

A 1-week follow up inspection will be conducted on 06.14.19.
All violations listed on the 06.07.19 routine inspection report shall be corrected no later than 06.14.19.

15. FOOD CONTACT SURFACES: CLEAN AND SANITIZED - MAJOR

Inspector Comments:

Operator requested for a follow up inspection but upon arrival, not all food equipment were washed, rinsed and sanitized. (ex: food containers, lids, interior surface of the convection oven)
Operator has to clean and sanitize all food equipment prior to requesting an inspection from this Agency.

Violation Description: All food contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean and sanitized. (113984(d), 114097, 114099.1, 114099.4, 114099.6, 114101(b-d), 114105, 114109, 114111, 114113, 114115(a, b ,d), 114117, 114125(b), 114141)

24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - MAJOR

Inspector Comments:

Rodent droppings were found on the floor surface beneath the storage shelves of Operators' stack of paper work and printers. Employee was instructed to remove the droppings, clean and sanitize the floor surface and shelving unit.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)

34. NONFOOD-CONTACT SURFACES CLEAN - MINOR

Inspector Comments:

Remove the accumulated food grime from the exterior surface of the convection oven.
See FM15.

Violation Description: All nonfood-contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean. (114115 [c])



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37. EQUIPMENT, UTENSILS AND LINENS: STORAGE AND USE - MINOR

Inspector Comments:

Rodent droppings were observed to have fallen out of a stack of papers stored on shelving unit in the kitchen area. These papers are serving as vermin harborage. Discontinue this practice. Remove all items from the facility which are unnecessary to the operation or maintenance of the facility.

Violation Description: All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.3, 114185.4, 114185.5)

44. PREMISES: PERSONAL/CLEANING ITEMS; VERMIN-PROOFING - MINOR

Inspector Comments:

There is a considerable gap (larger than 1/4 inch) all along the bottom of the two front doors. Properly rodent proof the interior/exterior of the premises. Seal all gaps that are greater than a 1/4 inch.

This violation has been temporarily corrected with spongy material. Operator stated an approved durable strip will be applied by Monday, June 10, 2019.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof; open-air barbecues shall be operated in an approved manner. (114067(j), 114123, 114143(a)&(b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282)
