### OPENING COMMENTS

The Purpose of this visit is to conduct a routine inspection. On this date the facility's health permit was suspended for lack of hot water. See FM 22.

#### 1. DEMONSTRATION OF KNOWLEDGE - MINOR

Inspector Comments: Employee education on handwashing requirements and warewashing techniques were provided during the inspection.

Violation Description: All food employees, including the person in charge, shall have adequate knowledge of and be trained in food safety as it relates to their assigned duties. (113947)

#### 2. FOOD MANAGER CERTIFICATION; FOOD HANDLER CARDS - MINOR

Inspector Comments: Food Safety Certificate unavailable at time of inspection. Provide Food Safety Certificate within 14 days. A reinspection is scheduled for September 2, 2019. To avoid a reinspection fee or additional administrative action, email a copy of your current Food Safety Certificate or proof of enrollment to DeSanchez@ochca.com

One of the employee food handler cards was expired at the time of inspection. Each food handler shall maintain a valid California Food Handler Card for the duration of his or her employment as a food handler. Cards shall be valid for three years from the date of issuance, regardless of whether the food handler changes employers during that period. (Certified Food Managers are exempted from this requirement.)

Violation Description: There shall be a Food Manager Certificate on the premises for the designated employee that has passed an approved and accredited exam. Food facilities that prepare, handle, or serve non-prepackaged food, shall ensure that all food handlers have an approved food handler card. (113947.1-113947.5, 113948)

#### 6. HANDS CLEAN AND PROPERLY WASHED; GLOVES USED PROPERLY - MAJOR

Inspector Comments: Observed an employee wash his hands at the 3-compartment sink and dry them with a cloth towel and then proceeded to the pizza assembly area. The employee was stopped prior to any food handling and instructed to wash his hands at the correct sink with soap and water and to dry them using a single use sanitary towel.

Violation Description: Employees are required to wash their hands with soap and warm water for a minimum of 10 seconds: before beginning work; before handling food / equipment / utensils; as often as necessary, during food preparation, to remove soil and contamination; when switching from working with raw to ready-to-eat foods, after touching body parts; after using toilet room; or any time when contamination may occur. Food employees shall minimize contact with exposed, ready-to-eat food with their bare hands and shall use suitable utensils, gloves, or dispensing equipment. Food employees shall keep their fingernails clean. Gloves shall be worn if a food employee has artificial nails, nail polish, rings, or orthopedic support devices. (113952, 113953.3, 113953.4, 113961, 113968, 113973 [b-f])

#### 14. FOOD IN GOOD CONDITION, SAFE AND UNADULTERATED - MINOR

Inspector Comments: Observed an unapproved item (2-liter soda bottle) stored in the edible ice bin resulting in contamination of the ice. Store only clean utensils in contact with the edible ice.

This violation was corrected by removing the item and discarding the affected ice.

Violation Description: Any food is adulterated if it bears or contains an unapproved food or color additive or any poisonous or deleterious substance that may render it impure or injurious to health. No food containing artificial trans fat or partially-hydrogenated oils may be stored, distributed, served, or used in the preparation of any food within a food facility. Potentially hazardous foods in reduced oxygen packaging shall not exceed the "use by" date. (113967, 113976, 113980, 113982, 113988, 113990, 114035, 114041, 114094.5, 114254.3)

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### 15. FOOD CONTACT SURFACES: CLEAN AND SANITIZED - MAJOR

Inspector Comments: Sanitizer was not being used during the manual handwashing.

Hand wash multi-service utensils in the following manner:

- a) clean in hot water and cleanser
- b) rinse in clear water
- c) immerse in a warm final sanitizing solution of 100 ppm chlorine for 30 seconds, 200 ppm quaternary ammonium for 1 minute, 25 ppm iodine for 1 minute or by immersion for at least 30 seconds where the water temperature is maintained at 171 degrees Fahrenheit or above,
- d) allow utensils to air dry before use

Education was provided on this date.

The employee was instructed to set up sanitizer solution in the final compartment of the 3-compartment sink.

Violation Description: All food contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean and sanitized. (113984(d), 114097, 114099.1, 114099.4, 114099.6, 114101(b-d), 114105, 114109, 114111, 114113, 114115(a, b, d), 114117, 114125(b), 114141)

### 22. HOT AND COLD WATER AVAILABLE - MAJOR

Inspector Comments: Hot water was not available in the facility. Provide hot water of atleast 120F to the 3 compartment sink.

Provide warm water to the handwash sink. If the temperature of water provided to a handwashing sink is not readily adjustable at the faucet, the temperature of the water shall be at least 100°F, but not greater than 108°F.

Violation Description: An adequate, protected, pressurized, potable supply of hot water and cold water shall be provided at all times. (113941, 113953c, 114099.2b, 114163, 114189, 114192, 114192.1, 114195)

### 24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - MINOR

Inspector Comments: Flies were observed in the dry storage room.

Eliminate the activity of flies/vermin from the food facility by using only approved methods. Remove all evidence of the infestation and thoroughly clean and sanitize all affected surfaces. Construct, equip, maintain and operate the food facility so as to prevent the entrance and harborage of animals, birds and vermin including, but not limited to, rodents and insects.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)

### 30. TOXIC SUBSTANCES PROPERLY IDENTIFIED, STORED, USED - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: 1. Observed a can of raid on the storage shelf. Remove this item from the facility.

Only those insecticides, rodenticides, and other pesticides that are necessary and specifically approved for use in a food facility may be used. The use shall be in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

2. Observed unlabeled spray bottles stored above the handwash sink. Label the bottles.

Working containers used for storing chemicals such as cleaners and sanitizers taken from bulk supplies shall be clearly and individually identified with the common name of the material.

Violation Description: All poisonous substances, detergents, bleaches, and cleaning compounds shall be stored separate from food, utensils, packaging materials, and food-contact surfaces, and shall be used in an approved manner. (114254, 114254.1, 114254.2)

### 34. NONFOOD-CONTACT SURFACES CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: 1. Observed a heavy accumulation of food debris and grease on the standing mixer base. Thoroughly clean to remove the accumulation.

2. Observed a residue on the gaskets of the 2-door keg cooler. Thoroughly clean to remove the residue.

Violation Description: All nonfood-contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean. (114115 [c])

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### 35. WAREWASHING FACILITIES: INSTALLED, MAINTAINED, USED; TEST STRIPS - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Sanitizer test strips were not available for use during the time of inspection. Maintain testing equipment and materials in the facility and available for use at all times for the purpose of adequately measuring the types of sanitization methods used in this facility.

Violation Description: Food facilities that prepare food shall be equipped with warewashing facilities. Testing equipment and materials shall be provided to measure the applicable sanitization method. (114067(f,g), 114099, 114099.3, 114099.5, 114101(a), 114101.1, 114101.2, 114103, 114107, 114125)

### 36. EQUIPMENT/UTENSILS - APPROVED; INSTALLED; GOOD REPAIR; CAPACITY - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: 1. Observed the gasket of the chest freezer in disrepair. Repair or replace the gasket in an approved manner.

2. Observed cloth towels and plastic bags tied around the pizza dough dispensing machine. Discontinue this practice. Equipment surfaces must be smooth, non-absorbent, durable, and easily cleanable. (i.e. raw wood, surfaces with gaps or crevices, etc.)

3. Observed duct tape on the handles of the 2-door reach-in cooler. Remove the tape and repair the cooler handles in an approved manner.

4. Observed a pizza dough knocker to be heavily deteriorated with chipped parts and missing pegs. Discontinue use of this tool.

Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114130.6, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114175, 114177, 114180, 114182)

### 37. EQUIPMENT, UTENSILS AND LINENS: STORAGE AND USE - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Observed carbon dioxide cylinders stored under the front counter to not be secured. All pressurized cylinders shall be securely fastened to a rigid structure.

Violation Description: All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.3, 114185.4, 114185.5)

### 38. ADEQUATE VENTILATION AND LIGHTING; DESIGNATED AREAS, USE - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Observed a heavy accumulation of debris on the hood and hood filters.

Violation Description: Exhaust hoods shall be provided to remove toxic gases, heat, grease, vapors, and smoke and be approved by the local building department. Canopy-type hoods shall extend 6" beyond all cooking equipment. All areas shall have sufficient ventilation to facilitate proper food storage. Toilet rooms shall be vented to the outside air by a screened openable window, an air shaft, or a light-switch activated exhaust fan, consistent with local building codes. Adequate lighting shall be provided in all areas to facilitate cleaning and inspection. Light fixtures in areas where open food is stored, served, prepared, and where utensils are washed shall be of shatterproof construction or protected with light shields. (114149, 114149.1, 114149.2, 114149.3, 114252, 114252.1)

### 39. THERMOMETERS PROVIDED AND ACCURATE - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Thermometers were not available in any of the cooler units. Provide an accurate display thermometer in all refrigeration units that is affixed to be readily visible and to indicate air temperature in the warmest part of the unit

Violation Description: An accurate, easily readable metal probe thermometer suitable for measuring temperature of food shall be available. A thermometer +/- 2°F shall be provided for each hot and cold holding unit of potentially hazardous foods and high temperature warewashing machines. (114157, 114159)



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**41. PLUMBING; PROPER BACKFLOW DEVICES - OUT OF COMPLIANCE**

Inspector Comments: Observed a leak at the faucet of the 3-compartment sink. Repair the leak in an approved manner.

Violation Description: The potable water supply shall be protected with a backflow protection device, as required by applicable plumbing codes. All plumbing, plumbing fixtures, and grease interceptors shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances, shall be maintained so as to prevent any contamination, and shall be kept clean, fully operative, and in good repair. Any hose used for conveying potable water shall be of approved materials, labeled, properly stored, and used for no other purpose. (14171, 114189.1, 114190, 114192, 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269)

**44. PREMISES: PERSONAL/CLEANING ITEMS; VERMIN-PROOFING - OUT OF COMPLIANCE**

Inspector Comments: Observed the front door propped open. Maintain the food facility fully enclosed to prevent the entrance and harborage of animals and insects at all times except during immediate passage.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof; open-air barbecues shall be operated in an approved manner. (114067(j), 114123, 114143(a)&(b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282)

**45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE**

Inspector Comments: 1. Observed a gap between the metal basecoving and the wall behind the 3-compartment sink. Seal the gap in an approved manner to prevent vermin harborage.

2. Observed a buildup on the wall behind and adjacent to the 2-door upright cooler. Thoroughly clean to remove the accumulation.

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, light-colored, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable, and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143(d), 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272)

**47. SIGNS POSTED; LAST INSPECTION REPORT AVAILABLE - OUT OF COMPLIANCE**

Inspector Comments: The last inspection report was unavailable for review at the public's request. Retain a copy of the most recent inspection report on the premises available for review at the request of the public.

Violation Description: Handwashing signs shall be posted in each toilet room, directing attention to the need to thoroughly wash hands after using the restroom. No smoking signs shall be posted in food preparation, food storage, warewashing, and utensil storage areas. Consumers shall be notified that clean tableware is to be used when they return to self-service areas such as salad bars and buffets. Any food facility constructed before January 1, 2004 without public toilet facilities, shall prominently post a sign within the food facility in a public area stating that toilet facilities are not provided. The most recent routine inspection report shall be maintained at the food facility and a sign shall be posted to advise patrons of its availability for review. The health permit must be posted in a conspicuous location. (113725.1, 113945.1, 113953.5, 113978, 114075, 114276, 114381 [e])



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**50. PERMIT SUSPENSION - IMMINENT HEALTH HAZARD**

Inspector Comments: IMMEDIATE HEALTH PERMIT SUSPENSION AND CLOSURE

The permit to operate the above named food facility is hereby temporarily suspended, and the facility is ordered immediately closed under the authority of Sections 114405 and 114409 of Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3 of the California Health and Safety Code. The attached Inspection Report specifies the conditions that warrant this closure and the Sections of the law that are being violated.

Any food facility for which the permit has been temporarily suspended shall cease all food handling, close and remain closed until all conditions warranting the closure are corrected and your permit has been reinstated by a representative of Environmental Health.

You are hereby notified that you have the right to request a hearing, within 15 calendar days after service of this Notice to show cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Your failure to request a hearing within 15 calendar days shall be deemed a waiver of your right to a hearing.

An owner, manager or operator who fails to comply with this Closure Notice may be found guilty of a misdemeanor, with a possible fine of \$1,000.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than six months for each offense.

This Health Permit Suspension and Closure Notice is issued to you under the authority of the California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3. Copies of the Code Sections referred to herein may be reviewed at most public libraries, the Internet, or at Environmental Health.

Contact this office at the number noted on this report, during normal days of business to request a re-inspection, or if you have any questions.

If you are calling after 5:00 pm or on weekends, leave a message at (714) 433-6418 and an inspector/on call staff will call you back at their earliest convenience. Please make after hour request calls before 8:00 pm. The afterhours overtime rate through June 30, 2020 is \$45.75 per quarter hour, or fraction thereof; time charged includes all travel time.

The CLOSED notification seal was issued this date.

REASON FOR CLOSURE: Lack of Hot Water

Violation Description: If an imminent health hazard is found, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility immediately closed. (114409)

**53. VOLUNTARY CONDEMNATION & DESTRUCTION (VC&D)**

Inspector Comments: Less than 1 pound of ice

Violation Description: Food, equipment, or utensils that are found to be unsanitary or in disrepair may be Voluntarily Condemned and Destroyed by the person in charge. (111890, 111895)
