OPENING COMMENTS

The purpose of this visit was to follow-up on violations as noted during the 1/22/2020 reinspection.

This inspection was at the request of J. Wilson, Owner.

On this date, the following was observed:

1. A thorough inspection was conducted, and no vermin activity was observed in any area of the facility.
2. The areas where vermin activity was previously observed were clean
3. The gaps below the roll-up doors in the dock area were observed to be sealed with a temporary fix. According to the owner, the roll-up door manufacturer was contacted for a quote for a properly fitting door sweep.
4. All ceiling tiles in the facility were observed to be sealed or properly fitting
5. All gaps around piping leading through the ceiling tiles were observed to be sealed with foam sealant

The permit to operate is hereby reinstated, and the facility may reopen.

* A reinspection has been scheduled to ensure the facility remains free of vermin activity.

Continue to correct the violations as noted on the previous reports.
