OPENING COMMENTS

This recheck was at the request of the PIC, D. Cuevas, after permit suspension on 11-18-19 for evidence of vermin activity. At this time all potential entry points were sealed and no evidence of activity was observed. Preventative pest control glue/snap traps were set up throughout.

A 1-week reinspection is scheduled to verify that activity was effectively and permanently eliminated.

Continue with approved pest control and monitor all areas of the facility. Continue to correct remaining violations noted on the routine inspection report dated 11-18-19 (installation of restroom self-closer, replace the broken display cooler door etc).
