OPENING COMMENTS

The purpose of this visit is a follow-up inspection for the continuous abatement of rodent activity. On this date the facility is hereby ordered closed due to rodent activity is critical areas. Refer to violation 24 and 50.

24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - MAJOR

Inspector Comments:

Observed the following rodent activity:

- 2 dead mice on the a sticky trap beneath the snack shelving on the sales floor near granola bars
- 1 Live on the sticky trap beneath the chip shelving on the sales floor across from the picture station
- Rodent droppings beneath the light up "Fuel N Go" shelving
- Rodent droppings beneath the shelving throughout the food area

Eliminate the infestation/activity of rodents from the food facility by using only approved methods.

Remove all evidence of the infestation and thoroughly clean and sanitize all affected surfaces.

Construct, equip, maintain and operate the food facility so as to prevent the entrance and harborage of animals, birds and vermin including, but not limited to, rodents and insects.

Management taped of the food area. No food or beverages are to be sold until the health permit is hereby reinstated by an inspector from this Agency.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)

44. PREMISES: PERSONAL/CLEANING ITEMS; VERMIN-PROOFING - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments:

1. Observed "SOS" pads placed beneath the single back door.
An employee stated the "SOS" pads were placed there to prevent the mice from entering.
Properly seal the door to prevent the entrance of vermin.

2. Observed a piping beneath the snack shelving on the sales floor.
Properly seal the piping on the sales floor.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof; open-air barbecues shall be operated in an approved manner. 45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments:

Observed an accumulation of shelving, and store equipment stored directly on the surface of the floor throughout the warehouse.
Discontinue storing equipment directly on the surface of the floor.
Provide a minimum of 6 inches of the surface of the floor.

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, light-colored, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable, and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143(d), 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272)



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50. PERMIT SUSPENSION - IMMINENT HEALTH HAZARD

Inspector Comments:
IMMEDIATE HEALTH PERMIT SUSPENSION AND CLOSURE

The permit to operate the above named food facility is hereby temporarily suspended, and the facility is ordered immediately closed under the authority of Sections 114405 and 114409 of Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3 of the California Health and Safety Code. The attached Inspection Report specifies the conditions that warrant this closure and the Sections of the law that are being violated.

Any food facility for which the permit has been temporarily suspended shall cease all food handling, close and remain closed until all conditions warranting the closure are corrected and your permit has been reinstated by a representative of Environmental Health.

You are hereby notified that you have the right to request a hearing, within 15 calendar days after service of this Notice to show cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Your failure to request a hearing within 15 calendar days shall be deemed a waiver of your right to a hearing.

An owner, manager or operator who fails to comply with this Closure Notice may be found guilty of a misdemeanor, with a possible fine of \$1,000.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than six months for each offense.

This Health Permit Suspension and Closure Notice is issued to you under the authority of the California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3. Copies of the Code Sections referred to herein may be reviewed at most public libraries, the Internet, or at Environmental Health.

Contact this office at the number noted on this report, during normal days of business to request a re-inspection, or if you have any questions.

If you are calling after 5:00 pm or on weekends, leave a message at (714) 433-6419 and an inspector/on call staff will call you back at their earliest convenience. REASON FOR CLOSURE:

Rodent activity in critical areas. Refer to violation 24.

Violation Description: If an imminent health hazard is found, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility immediately closed. (114409)
