#### OPENING COMMENTS

##### PERMIT REINSTATEMENT

This inspection is at the request of U. Villa in response to a permit suspension on 6-11-18 for cockroach infestation. The conditions causing the permit suspension were observed to be corrected. Your permit to operate is hereby reinstated.

A pest control invoice dated 6-11-18 was provided. No re-entry time was indicated on the report. The person-in-charge stated that the pest control technician allowed re-entry three hours after treatment.

A reinspection has been scheduled for 7-5-18. Reinspection fees are applied for your next visit. Please continue to make repairs to the wall behind the cook's line. See items listed below.

#### 24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - MINOR

Inspector Comments: Dead cockroaches were observed in the following areas:

1. one on the panel between the equipment under the dish machine
2. one inside the inoperable 3-door reach-in cooler
3. one underneath the mop sink

Corrective action: All roaches were immediately removed and the affected areas were sanitized. A thorough inspection for vermin activity was conducted and no further evidence was found.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)

#### 44. PREMISES: PERSONAL/CLEANING ITEMS; VERMIN-PROOFING - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: A.) Seal the cracks/crevices in the walls in the following areas:

1. between the wall corners by the Murray electric panel with the red switch
2. on the floor/wall juncture by the oven at the cook's line

Corrective action: All items were immediately sealed with a cement caulking.

B.) Continue to make the repairs to the panel on the wall at the cook's line. Please ensure this item is corrected by the reinspection scheduled for 7-5-18.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof; open-air barbecues shall be operated in an approved manner.
