OPENING COMMENTS

The purpose of this visit is to conduct a follow up inspection on the violations noted on the Compliance Hearing Report. On this date all the cooking equipment previously located in the front kitchen area has been disconnected and re-located to the back warehouse unit for storage. The following equipment appeared to be commercial grade: the "Stratus" flat grill, the "Everest" 2-door cooler drawer, and the "Radiant" 4-burner stove top. Provide the equipment specifications to this Agency once you are ready to submit the 3-set of plans. The flat grill with the 2-compartment hot holding units was observed to not be NSF and/or commercial and needs to be removed completely from this facility as noted on the Compliance Hearing Report. In addition a thorough inspection for vermin activity was conducted on this date and no further evidence was observed. The conditions causing the permit suspension were observed to be corrected. Your permit to operate is hereby reinstated.
