**OPENING COMMENTS**

This reopening re-inspection was at the request of Alex Flores, manager, in response to a permit suspension on October 04, 2019, due to the drain pipe spilling wastewater onto the sidewalk areas when the sinks were in use, including the 3-compartment sink. Refer to the inspection report from October 04, 2019, for more information.

Upon arrival, Alex Flores, manager, and Ryan McCammon, plumbing technician, was on-site. R. McCammon had replaced the broken drain pipe draining in the submersible pump pit/basin that was causing wastewater to spill onto the sidewalk areas. All sinks were turned on simultaneously and all wastewater was collected inside the submersible pump pit/basin then pumped out once it reached the water limit level. No wastewater was observed to be spilling outside the submersible pit/basin areas. This facility may reopen when all affected areas outside have been cleaned and sanitized.

NOTE: The plumbing and drainage into the submersible pump pit/basin will be evaluated and a follow-up will be made at a later date. Photos were taken and will be uploaded.
