OPENING COMMENTS

The purpose of this visit was to perform a joint consultation with T. Zerba, from the City of Santa Ana - Planning and Building Agency, as the facility has reportedly removed multiple sinks from the facility.

On this date, it was observed that facility removed a handwashing sink, a janitorial sink, and added new equipment including an upright two-door cooler and some storage racks.

7. ADEQUATE HANDWASHING FACILITIES SUPPLIED & ACCESSIBLE - MINOR

Inspector Comments: Observed the handwashing sink to have been removed at the preparation area.

Violation Description: Handwashing facilities must be provided. Handwashing soap and single-use towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. Handwashing facilities shall be clean, unobstructed, and accessible. (113953, 113953.1, 113953.2, 114067)

22. HOT AND COLD WATER AVAILABLE - MINOR

Inspector Comments: Measured the water temperature at the three compartment sink to be 104 F.

The hot water at the 3-compartment sink is not sufficient. Provide a minimum of 120 F hot water.

Violation Description: An adequate, protected, pressurized, potable supply of hot water and cold water shall be provided at all times. (113941, 113953c, 114099.2b, 114163, 114189, 114192, 114192.1, 114195)

36. EQUIPMENT/UTENSILS - APPROVED; INSTALLED; GOOD REPAIR; CAPACITY - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Observed the janitorial sink to have been removed.

Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114130.6, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114175, 114177, 114180, 114182)



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48. PLAN REVIEW - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Construction work was observed to be taking place at this facility. Immediately discontinue this project. Submit plans and specifications to this office for review and approval for the remodel or construction prior to beginning or continuing work on the project. A construction guide was provided this date. Assure all applicable permits are obtained (i.e. City Building).

This facility is being referred to Orange County Environmental Health Plan Check Division. The facility must submit a Plan Check Service Request form with plans, if required below, to Plan Check located at 1241 E. Dyer Road, Suite 120, Santa Ana, CA 92705 during normal business hours. Complete information related to Plan Check can be found at www.ocfoodinfo.com/plancheck. A fee is required at the time of plan check submittal. The Plan Check operator can be reached at 714-433-6074.

The scope of the construction includes the following: The handwashing sink was removed, the mop sink was removed, new equipment was added without prior approval, wall partitions do not allow for sufficient working space, etc.

You are required to: Submit Plans for a Remodel

This facility is: A previously permitted facility under new ownership

The construction is: Complete

Please bring this report with you when submitting the Service Request and plans.

Approval is required prior to starting construction, remodeling, or making changes.

Violation Description: A person proposing to build or remodel a food facility shall submit plans for approval before starting any new construction or remodeling of any facility for use as a retail food facility. (114380)



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52. PERMIT SUSPENSION

Inspector Comments: IMMEDIATE HEALTH PERMIT SUSPENSION AND CLOSURE

The permit to operate the above named food facility is hereby temporarily suspended, and the facility is ordered immediately closed under the authority of Sections 114405 and 114409 of Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3 of the California Health and Safety Code. The attached Inspection Report specifies the conditions that warrant this closure and the Sections of the law that are being violated.

Any food facility for which the permit has been temporarily suspended shall cease all food handling, close and remain closed until all conditions warranting the closure are corrected and your permit has been reinstated by a representative of Environmental Health.

You are hereby notified that you have the right to request a hearing, within 15 calendar days after service of this Notice to show cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Your failure to request a hearing within 15 calendar days shall be deemed a waiver of your right to a hearing.

An owner, manager or operator who fails to comply with this Closure Notice may be found guilty of a misdemeanor, with a possible fine of \$1,000.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than six months for each offense.

This Health Permit Suspension and Closure Notice is issued to you under the authority of the California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3. Copies of the Code Sections referred to herein may be reviewed at most public libraries, the Internet, or at Environmental Health.

Contact this office at the number noted above, during normal days of business to request a re-inspection, or if you have any questions.

If you are calling after 5:00 pm or on weekends, leave a message at (714) 433-6418 and an inspector/on call staff will call you back at their earliest convenience. Please make after hour request calls before 8:00 pm. The afterhours overtime rate through June 30, 2018 is \$44.63 per quarter hour, or fraction thereof; time charged includes all travel time.

The CLOSED notification seal was issued this date.

REASON FOR CLOSURE: Unapproved construction/remodeling.

Violation Description: An enforcement officer may suspend or revoke the permit for non-compliance or for interference in the performance of the duty of the enforcement officer. (114405, 114409, 114411)
