The purpose of this visit is to conduct a second or greater reopening inspection at the request of R. Olvera (Manager) in response to a permit suspension issued on 01-15-20.

On this date, a thorough inspection of vermin activity was conducted. No rodent activity was observed in the facility. The violations noted on the previous routine inspection report and the previous reinspection report were observed to be corrected.

Continue to monitor all areas of the facility for activity and continue with approved pest control measures.

The conditions causing the permit suspension were observed to be corrected. Your permit to operate is hereby reinstated.

A one week follow-up inspection is scheduled for 01-27-20 to verify continued abatement of vermin activity.
