**OPENING COMMENTS**

**PERMIT REINSTATEMENT**

This inspection is at the request of I. Nguyen, Manager, in response to a permit suspension on 6/11/2018 due to a rodent infestation. The conditions causing the permit suspension were observed to be corrected.

- No rodent activity was observed on this date; all areas appeared to be cleaned and sanitized
- The gaps under the rear kitchen door have been eliminated; a new black screen door with a door sweep has been installed
- The gaps under the rear facility door in the banquet hall have been eliminated; new door sweeps were installed
- The hole in the ceiling panel above the life-support tank has been sealed.

Your permit to operate is hereby reinstated.

A follow-up inspection has been scheduled on 6/19/2018 to verify that the facility remains in compliance.

**44. PREMISES: PERSONAL/CLEANING ITEMS; VERMIN-PROOFING - OUT OF COMPLIANCE**

Inspector Comments:

Observed numerous holes/gaps in the ceiling panels located in the main banquet hall. Repair/replace the ceiling panels so as to eliminate the gaps. Properly rodent proof the interior/exterior of the premises. Seal all gaps that are greater than a 1/4 inch.

This violation will be followed up on 6/19/2018.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof; open-air barbecues shall be operated in an approved manner.
