Items noted below were observed during the course of this inspection. Any violations observed must be corrected. Failure to correct the listed violation(s) prior to the designated compliance date may necessitate a reinspection at an additional fee.

**OPENING COMMENTS**

The purpose of this visit is at the request of N. Guerrero, GM for Glowzone, to conduct a reinspection of a facility that was closed for rodent activity in critical areas of the facility. See previous inspection report for details.

At the time of reinspection, pest control service receipts showing service to the facility the day prior were provided. A thorough reinspection for vermin was conducted and no further evidence of rodent activity was observed.

All of the violations on the previous inspection report were observed corrected with the exception of violation FM45 where the floor tiles at the base of the rear double door still needed to be repaired. According to the manager, N. Guerrero, someone will be coming in to repair the floor tiles in the next few days.

The conditions causing the permit suspension were observed corrected and your health permit is hereby reinstated. A one week reinspection has been scheduled to verify that the facility remains free of vermin.

**45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE**

Inspector Comments: Repair or replace the cracked/missing floor tiles observed by the rear double door entrance.

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, light-colored, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable, and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143(d), 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272)
