OPENING COMMENTS

The purpose of this visit was to conduct a follow-up inspection to verify the abatement of rodent activity that resulted in the suspension of this facility's health permit.

A thorough inspection for vermin activity was conducted. No new evidence was observed. No droppings were observed in any critical areas. Rodent traps were observed throughout the edges of the facility.

On this date, the holes noted on the last inspection report were observed sealed.

The permit is hereby reinstated and the facility may reopen. A one week reinspection has been scheduled to verify continued absence of vermin activity.

An office conference has been scheduled for the operator on 10/17/19 at 8:00 AM, at 1241 E. Dyer Rd., Santa Ana CA 92705 to provide an opportunity to present evidence as to why the facility's permit should not be modified, suspended or revoked due to serious or repeated violations of the California Health and Safety Code.
