OPENING COMMENTS

This reinspection is at the request of the facility operator in response to a permit suspension on 11/06/19 for rodent activity.

The conditions causing the permit suspension were observed to be corrected on site (See Fm 24 and 44). Your permit to operate is hereby reinstated.

A reinspection is scheduled for 11/22/19 to verify that the vermin activity does not return.

24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: 1) Observed multiple rodent droppings at the following locations:

- On the floor near the handwash sink behind the front counter.
- In the handwash sink behind the front counter
- On the molding along the wall in the bathroom area
- In the corner under the shelving units in the back dry goods storage room

2) Observed numerous fruit flies in the beer bottle recycling room.

Eliminate the infestation/activity of cockroaches/rodents/flies/vermin from the food facility by using only approved methods. Remove all evidence of the infestation and thoroughly clean and sanitize all affected surfaces. Construct, equip, maintain and operate the food facility so as to prevent the entrance and harborage of animals, birds and vermin including, but not limited to, rodents and insects.

CORRECTIVE ACTION: The person in charge removed the rodent droppings and cleaned and sanitized the area in which they were found. The flies in the beer bottle recycling room were killed and removed from the facility and the area in which they were found was cleaned and sanitized by the person in charge.

CORRECTED ON SITE

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)

Inspector Comments: Observed a gap greater than 1/4inch under the handwash sinks in the bathroom area.

Seal the gap.

CORRECTIVE ACTION: The person in charge sealed the gap with spacking paste at the time of inspection.

Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof; open-air barbecues shall be operated in an approved manner.
