**OPENING COMMENTS**

This visit was at the request of N. Pham, owner, to conduct a re-inspection in attempt to reinstate the health permit suspended on 6-6-17 during a re-inspection.

On this date, a thorough inspection for live cockroach activity was conducted. No evidence of cockroach activity was observed. The operator provided pest control receipts dating this date, 6-7-19.

The violations warranting a suspended health permit have been corrected. The health permit is hereby reinstated.

A re-inspection seal was issued on this date.

**34. NONFOOD-CONTACT SURFACES CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE**

Inspector Comments: Thoroughly clean to remove accumulated dust from the storage racks located on the cook's line.

Violation Description: All nonfood-contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean. (114115 [c])

Inspector Comments: Observed the gasket to the walk-in cooler door to be deteriorated from the lower corner of the walk-in door. Repair or replace the gasket to eliminate any space, gaps, or openings.

Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114130.6, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114175, 114177, 114180, 114182)

**NOTES**

Consult with your fire service company in regards to the ansel system over the 2-burner open flame unit. Ensure the 2-burner unit is under compliance in the area located beneath the hood.
