OPENING COMMENTS

The visit was at the request of Natcha Yosphayungsak to follow-up with the rodent activity that resulted in a permit suspension on November 14, 2019. All violations that warranted a permit suspension have been corrected. The dish machine was also observed to be repaired and dispensing the proper 50 ppm chlorine at the final rinse cycle. All holes and gaps were observed to be properly sealed/covered.

A re-inspection has been scheduled for November 22, 2019, to ensure that no further rodent activity is observed. Refer to FM24.

24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - MINOR

Inspector Comments: 1) Observed two rodent droppings under the unused 3-compartment sink in the unused equipment storage room area. No retail food or equipment is stored in this room.

2) Observed two rodent droppings on the floor in the storage room by the customer dining area. No retail food or equipment is stored in this room.

A thorough inspection for vermin activity was conducted. No further evidence was observed.

Corrective action: Clean and sanitize all affected areas.

A re-inspection has been scheduled for November 22, 2019, to ensure no further rodent activity is observed.

Eliminate the infestation/activity of cockroaches/rodents/flies/vermin from the food facility by using only approved methods. Remove all evidence of the infestation and thoroughly clean and sanitize all affected surfaces. Construct, equip, maintain and operate the food facility so as to prevent the entrance and harborage of animals, birds and vermin including, but not limited to, rodents and insects.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)
