#### OPENING COMMENTS

This re-inspection visit was prompted by a call received from A. Kumar in attempt to reopen this facility during the previous routine inspection for rodent activity.

On this date, pest control receipt dating 1-21-2020 was provided. A thorough inspection for rodent activity was conducted. No evidence of live rodent activity was observed.

A re-inspection seal has been issued on this date. The violations warranting a closure have now been corrected. This facility is now open to the public.

#### 45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: 1. Observed debris on the floor next to the large electric box. The person in charge removed the debris before the end of this inspection.

2. Observed cracks and crevices on the ceiling panel located on the right corner above the hood. Seal the cracks and crevices prior to the scheduled one-week reinspection.

3. Observed an opening on the left side of the electric box. Seal the opening to eliminate possible harborage of rodents inside the electric box.

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, light-colored, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable, and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143(d), 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272)
