#### OPENING COMMENTS

The purpose of today's visit is to conduct a reinspection, as requested by the person in charge, B. Padilla, to verify the correction of the conditions causing the health permit suspension and closure noted on 6/11/2018.

The infestation/activity of rodents from the food facility was eliminated by using only approved methods. All evidence of the infestation was eliminated and all affected surfaces were thoroughly cleaned and sanitized. All noted and observed crevices (i.e. gaps and cracks) were sealed throughout the facility to eliminate potential vermin (including insects) harborage. A more permanent seal will be verified at the one-week reinspection.

The facility is observed in compliance. You may now open for business.

The facility will continue to correct the violations noted on this inspection report and on the inspection reports dated 6/11/2018.

A one-week reinspection has been scheduled to verify continued compliance.

A "Reinspection Due Pass" seal was posted this date.
