OPENING COMMENTS

This report supersedes the handwritten report dated 10/22/2019.

This after hours reinspection was at the request of S. Park due to a permit suspension for lack of hot water at the food facility. The hot water was measured at 124-125 degrees Fahrenheit at the utensil wash sink, mop sink and the hand wash sinks. Also observed the cold top preparation cooler holding an ambient air temperature of 43 degrees Fahrenheit. Noted cream was at 43 degrees Fahrenheit in this unit. S. Park indicated the cream was in the refrigerator less than 4 hours. The potentially hazardous foods in this unit were relocated to the walk in cooler. Repair the cooler unit to maintain potentially hazardous foods at or below 41 degrees Fahrenheit. Discontinue storing potentially hazardous food in the cooler until it is repaired and verified for compliance in writing by this Agency. Noted the back door was propped open. Maintain the doors closed so as to prevent vermin entry. The conditions causing the permit suspension were noted corrected. A reinspection to verify the violations are corrected recorded on the report dated earlier today is scheduled with your inspector on Thursday, October 24, 2019. A Pass Reinspection seal was posted.
