Inspector Comments: The soap dispenser for the restroom was not working. Provide a soap dispenser for the restroom.

Violation Description: Handwashing facilities must be provided. Handwashing soap and single-use towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. Handwashing facilities shall be clean, unobstructed, and accessible. (113953, 113953.1, 113953.2, 114067)

43. TOILET FACILITIES: PROPERLY CONSTRUCTED, SUPPLIED, CLEANED - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Observed toilet paper stored outside of the dispenser. Provide toilet paper inside the toilet paper dispenser.

Violation Description: Toilet facilities shall be maintained clean, sanitary, and in good repair. Toilet rooms shall be separated by a well-fitting self-closing door. Toilet tissue shall be provided in a permanently installed dispenser at each toilet. The number of toilet facilities shall be in accordance with local building and plumbing ordinances. Toilet facilities shall be provided for patrons: in establishments where there is onsite consumption of food; with more than 20,000 sq ft.; establishments offering on-site liquor consumption.
