OPENING COMMENTS

This re-inspection visit was prompted by P. Patel, Manager, to follow up with the compliance of the rodent activity that caused temporary permit suspension on the routine inspection.

During this visit, old rodent droppings were observed, however no further evidence of rodent activity was observed. See Report for details.

The health permit is hereby reinstated. The facility is now open to the public.

24. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS - OUT OF COMPLIANCE

Inspector Comments: Observed old rodent droppings on the floor beneath the soda storage racks closest to the Snapple 1-door refrigerator.

Corrective Action: The old rodent droppings were removed and the affected floors were cleaned and sanitized. A thorough inspection for rodent activity was conducted and no further evidence was observed.

Violation Description: Each food facility shall be kept free of insects, birds, animals, or vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259, 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5)
