**OPENING COMMENTS**

The purpose of this visit is to conduct a re-opening inspection as requested by T. Phan, the owner.

The water temperature was measured above 120F at the three compartment sink (Up to 140F). The sinks were ran for several minutes and it was determined that an adequate supply of hot water was available. The uncorrected violations noted during the 7-1-19 routine inspection were observed corrected at this time.

The health permit was re-instated at this time.

A re-inspection is tentatively scheduled for 7-9-19, to verify the continued correction of major violations FM06, FM08, and FM15, during active food operations, as noted during the 7-1-19 routine inspection.
